

Logline

Synopsis

Peter Pickens is not his real name, and this is not his real life. He knows this because he is haunted by dreams of a woman he doesn't recognize and nightmares of water torture. So when he awakens to the incessant dripping of a leaky pipe, his sanity cracks with every drop. His only recourse in the dead of night is an app called Plumr. But Plumr is a hook-up app, and the person who arrives at his door is far from what he imagined, yet may hold the key to his freedom.



Director's Statement

I originally intended for Plumr to be the first in a series of short films featuring Peter Pickens, a former Special Operative who while incredibly gifted, lacked a fundamental element of common sense. Sort of a James Bond with a sprinkle of Pink Panther. Each film would show Peter dealing with a new obstacle (partly of his own making) as he eventually tries to find his way back to his lover in Brasil. As production on Plumr progressed, I realized that I had neither the time, resources or passion for future films in the series. So I re-wrote the script to make Plumr self contained.

With Plumr, I wanted to make a high quality action film on a meager budget while filming in 3 countries. It was my first foray into significant makeup and critical on-set dialogue. I also wanted to experiment with fog and some new camera movement techniques. It turned out to be a much more daunting project than expected (surprise), but the final result was worth the efforts.




Bradley Silvius Writer/Director
